- Discussion of the formal ballot language approval process.
- Discussion of John Chmil's efforts to draft precise and legally defensible ballot language that provides the District the ability to maneuver to meet current and future funding and public transparency/TABOR requirements.
- Board Discussion:

-Director Hansen: commented that voter education will be paramount to get this ballot effort passed. Chief Kazian: discussion of TABOR's influence over ballot language. -Director Gillingham: How can we educate the public on what De-Gallagher means for the District and its taxpayers? Chief Kazian: discussion of current efforts to educate the public about De-Gallagher amid the challenges everyone faces as with the lead up to the November 2020 election (video, FAQ page on website and social media posts).

-Director Rosen: How does De-Gallagher impact the District's previously passed 2019 Mill Levy? What are its COLA impacts? Chief Kazian: Discussion of general mathematics involved to maintain current residential assessment income by manipulating the 2019 mill rate depending on the outcome of the De-Gallagher election. Changing the Mill Rate will impact all property (commercial, agricultural and residential) whereas the De-Gallagher will only impact residential assessment and is not a tax increase.

-Director Rosen: supportive of District's current and past efforts to educate the public about its ballot proposals. Chief Kazian: discussion of the De-Gallagher efforts of other fire districts and the various restrictions associated with TABOR.

2. Resolution 2020-07 to Approve November 2020 De-Gallagher Ballot Language

Director Gillingham submits a motion to approve Resolution 2020-07, Director Stevenson seconds. All "aye". Approved.
